

EXHIBIT A

Relevant Rehoboth Beach Laws

1. Alcohol Possession and/or Consumption by Minors - §83-1 and §83-2 – Civil offense to have or consume alcohol within the City limits while under the age of 21.

2. Open Container - §83-4 – Civil offense to drink any intoxicating beverage while on a public street, sidewalk, boardwalk or beach regardless of age.

3. Noise, Sound Amplification - §189- 7 – Criminal citation, No person shall use sound-amplifying equipment without a permit.

4. Interfering with a police officer - §198-20 – interfering or inciting another to interfere with a police officer in the performance of their duties – Criminal misdemeanor.

5. Disturbing the peace - §198-21 – Disturbing the peace and quiet of the City – Civil citation.

6. Unlawful assemblies - §198-22 – may not participate in an assembly characterized by actual force or violence, willful destruction of property, the threat of either of the above or any other “tumultuous or violent disturbance of the peace” by two or more persons – Civil citation.

7. Loitering §198-24 – loiter, loaf, wander, stand or remain idle alone and/or with a group in a public place in a way that obstructs, hinders or impedes free passage or obstructs or interferes with free use of property or businesses – Criminal misdemeanor.

8. Disorderly conduct §198-25 – Acting with purpose of causing danger, alarm, disorder, nuisance or if likely to cause any of these things, a person (1) disturbs public order by violence, (2) engages in fighting, threatening, or tumultuous behavior, (3) makes any unreasonably loud noise, (4) uses abusive language or threats to a person present with clear and present danger of violence, (5) causes likelihood or harm or serious inconvenience by failing to obey a lawful order to disburse by a police officer where acts of disorderly conduct are in the immediate vicinity, (6) damages property so as to create hazardous, unhealthy or physically offensive condition, (7) commits trespass, (8) is drunk, intoxicated or under influence in public place, (9) assemble a crowd for unlawful, mischievous purpose to the annoyance or inconvenience of others or incites a riot, (10) assembles, loiters, blocks or impedes passage and fails to disperse on command of police, (11) jostles or roughly crowds people, (12) stands, loiters or strolls seeking money or things of

values from others, (13) remaining on property when closed, and (14) uses lewd or filthy language, or threatening language toward another, or obscene gestures likely to provoke retaliation and breach of peace – Criminal misdemeanor.

9. Urinating in public - §198-37.1 – Unlawful to urinate on public property (other than in designated facilities), boardwalk, or beach – Civil citation.

10. Smoking marijuana prohibited - §224-3 – Prohibited at all times in all public places – Civil offense.

11. Restrictions on use of umbrellas or other fixtures (beach) - §95-2.1(c) – ...unless used in conjunction with an event or ceremony where the use has been specifically included in an event permit issued by the City Manager at least 15 days in advance of the intended use...tents, tarps, cabanas, pavilions, canopies, sports-brellas, temporary bathroom facilities, or similar devices, or any materials mounted on supports, are prohibited.

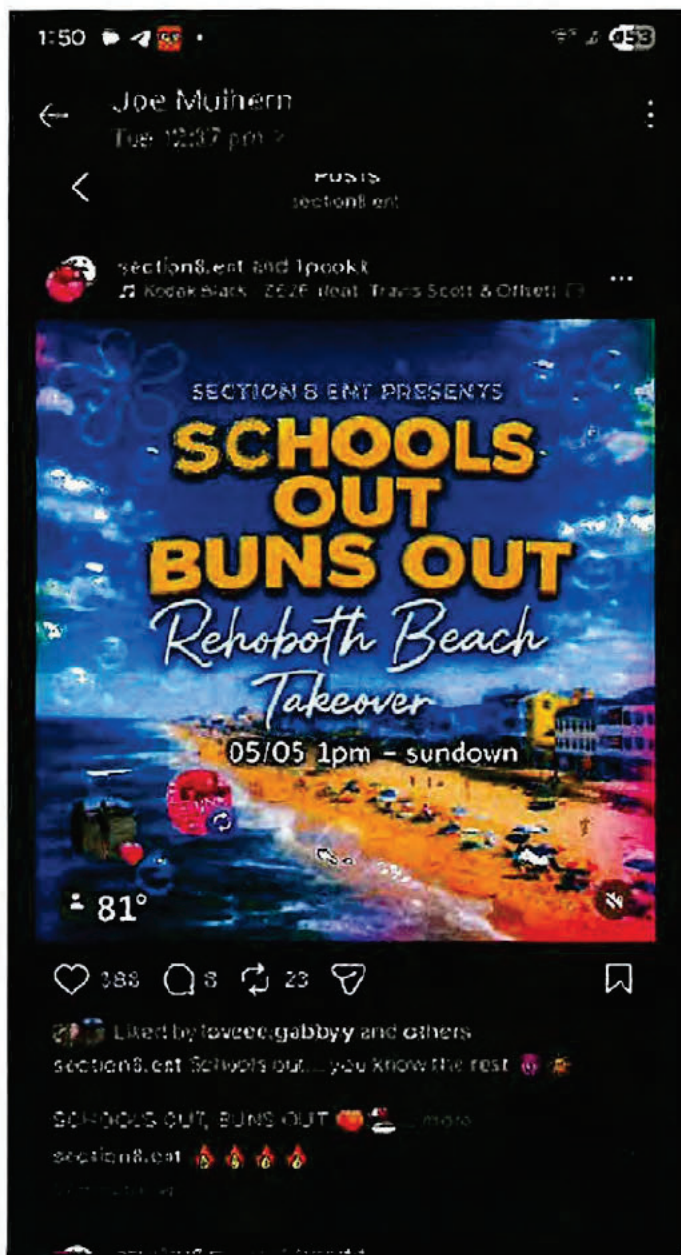

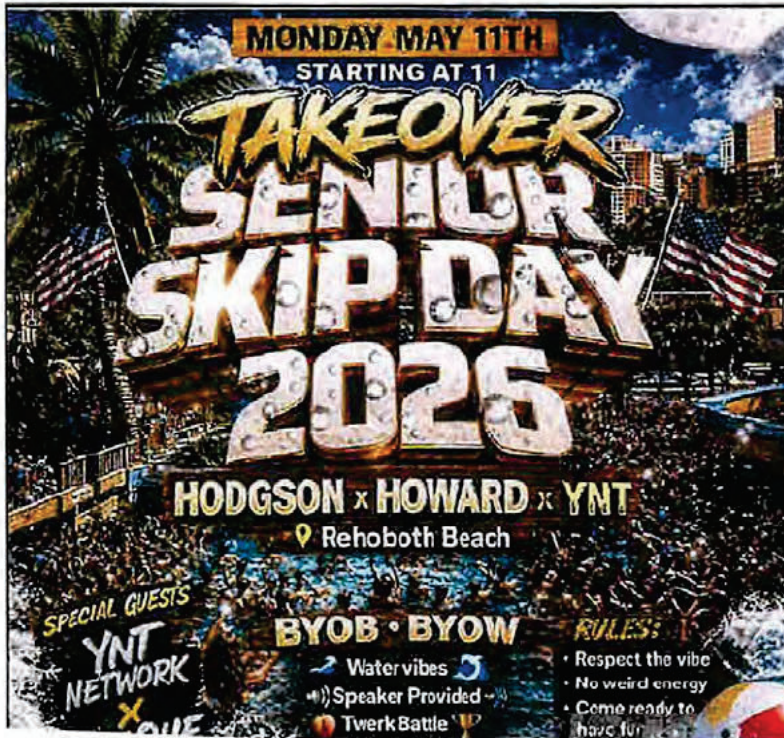

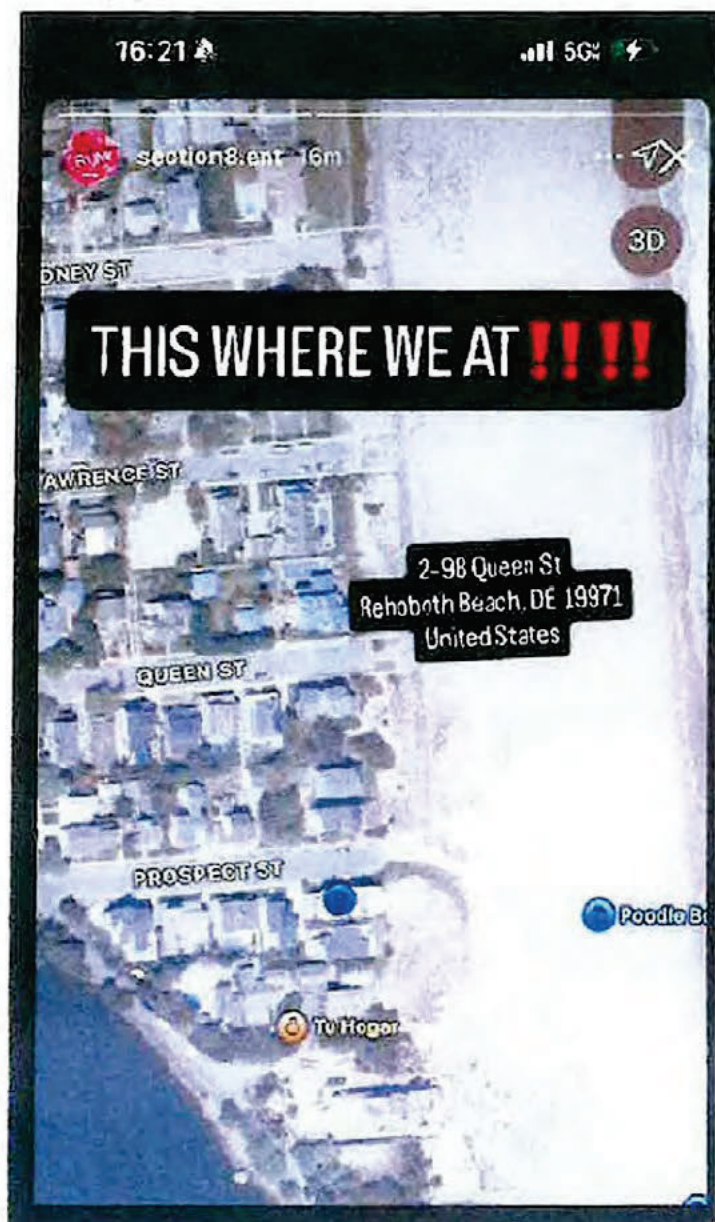

1. Your affiant [REDACTED] can truly state that: 1. Your affiant is a sworn police officer with the Rehoboth Beach Police Department, currently assigned to criminal investigations. Your affiant is sworn to statewide jurisdiction. Your affiant has been employed since May 2018 with the City of Rehoboth Beach. Your affiant successfully completed a six-month training course at the Delaware State Police Academy in accordance with requirements of the Council of Police Training, now POST, in February 2016. This training included studies in constitutional law, criminal law, arrest procedures, and development of arrests and search warrants. The statements contained in this affidavit are based in part upon information provided by suspect(s), witnesses, and other Law Enforcement Officers, along with your affiant's experience and background as a Law Enforcement Officer. Since this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing an arrest warrant, your Affiant has not included each and every fact known concerning this investigation. However, your Affiant does not believe he has excluded any fact or circumstance that would tend to defeat the establishment of probable cause for this arrest warrant. Your Affiant has set forth only the facts that your Affiant believes are necessary to establish probable cause. Additionally, your affiant has been involved in the preparation and execution of numerous search and seizure warrants.

2. On 5/19/2026 at approximately 1155 hours, Rehoboth Beach Police Department was notified of a "takeover" event that was being shared on social media. The flyer for the event read "Section 8 Presents Summer Takeover Rehoboth Beach 5/19 2PM-Sundown". The event was posted on Instagram by "Section8.ent". On "Section8.ent"'s Instagram page [REDACTED] [REDACTED] were listed on the page as the promoters. On 4/1/2026 after a party in within the limits of Wyoming, Delaware, the aforementioned were identified as the promoters of "Section8.ent" by police officers from DATE and DSU PD.

3. On 5/5/2026 "Section8.ent" hosted a beach takeover. During that event I spoke with [REDACTED] who identified himself as a person in charge. I also spoke with [REDACTED] during that event. [REDACTED] spoke with [REDACTED] during the 5/5/2026 event. During the 5/5/2026 event multiple civil arrest were made for public urination. I turned off a music speaker during the event after no one around it would claim it as theirs.

4. During the 5/19/2026 event [REDACTED] spoke with [REDACTED] who again was identified as a promoter of the party. [REDACTED] had to request the music be turned down and off due to the amount of unreasonable noise it created.

5. As the evening progressed a total of approximately 650-750 party goers arrived to various locations within the City of Rehoboth Beach. Throughout the evening members of the takeover were arrested for underage possession/consumption of alcohol, marijuana possession/smoking, disorderly conduct, resisting arrest, and other traffic charges. The party goers left substantial trash and debris throughout multiple areas in the city including the beach, parking lots, Surf Ave., Rehoboth Ave., Bandstand area, Boardwalk, and the ocean blocks of most streets. Officers responded to two fights from members of the takeover crowd.

6. Due to the takeovers crowds disorderly actions at least six businesses closed early.

7. Multiple residents and guest of the City of Rehoboth Beach commented on social media about how disorderly the crowd from the takeover was and that they caused them to feel unsafe.

8. To disperse the crowd Rehoboth Beach Police requested assistance from Dewey Beach Police (3 officers), Milford Police Department (1 K9 Unit), Bethany Beach Police Department (2 officers), DNREC (3 officers),

Delaware State Police Troop 7 (5 Troopers), Delaware State Police Troop 4 (1 Trooper), Lewes Police Department (2 officers).

9. Given the aforementioned facts, it is clear that [REDACTED] are aware that the takeover events they promote quickly grown and cause disorderly behavior from the participants. The four of have promoted and participated in multiple events that have created unreasonable noise, people fighting, and creating hazardous or physically offensive conditions for no legitimate purposes.

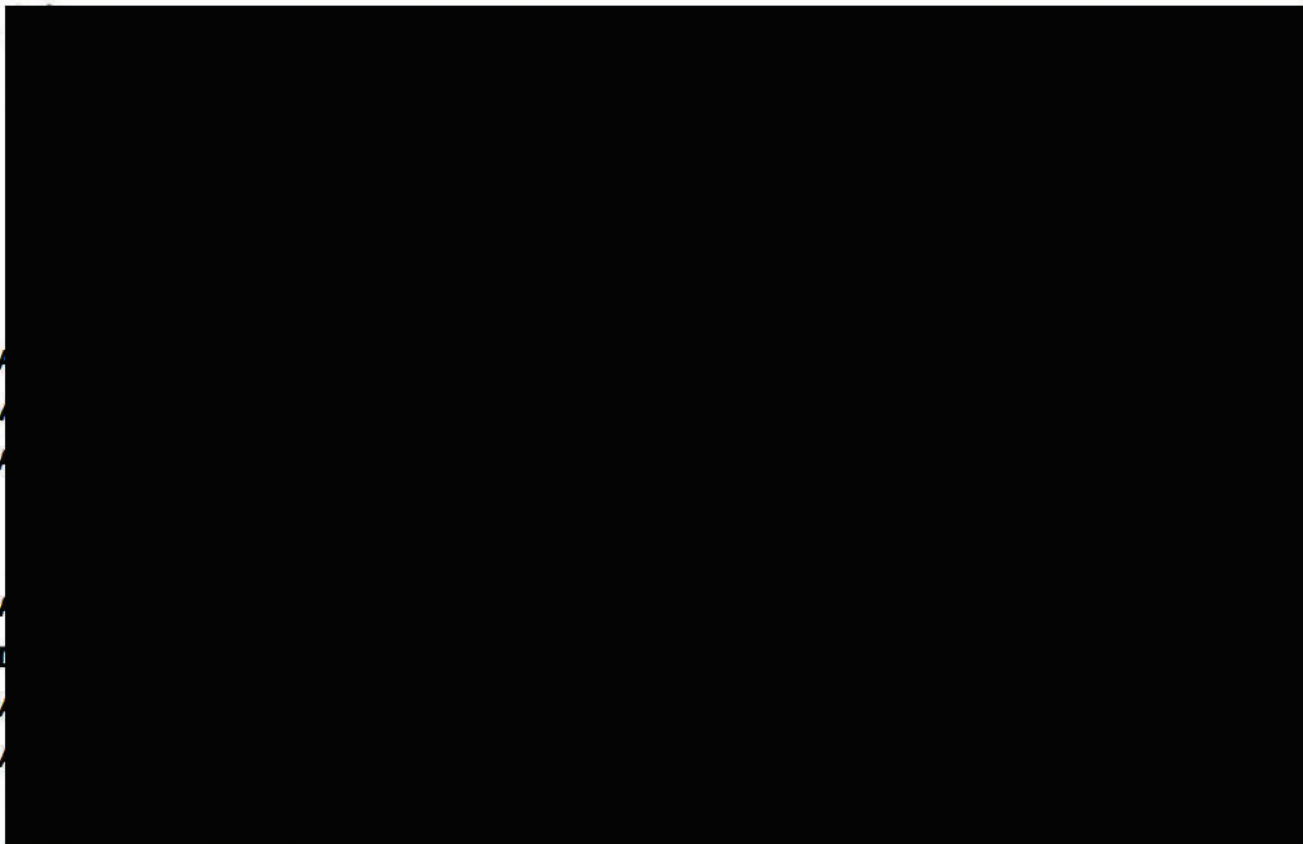

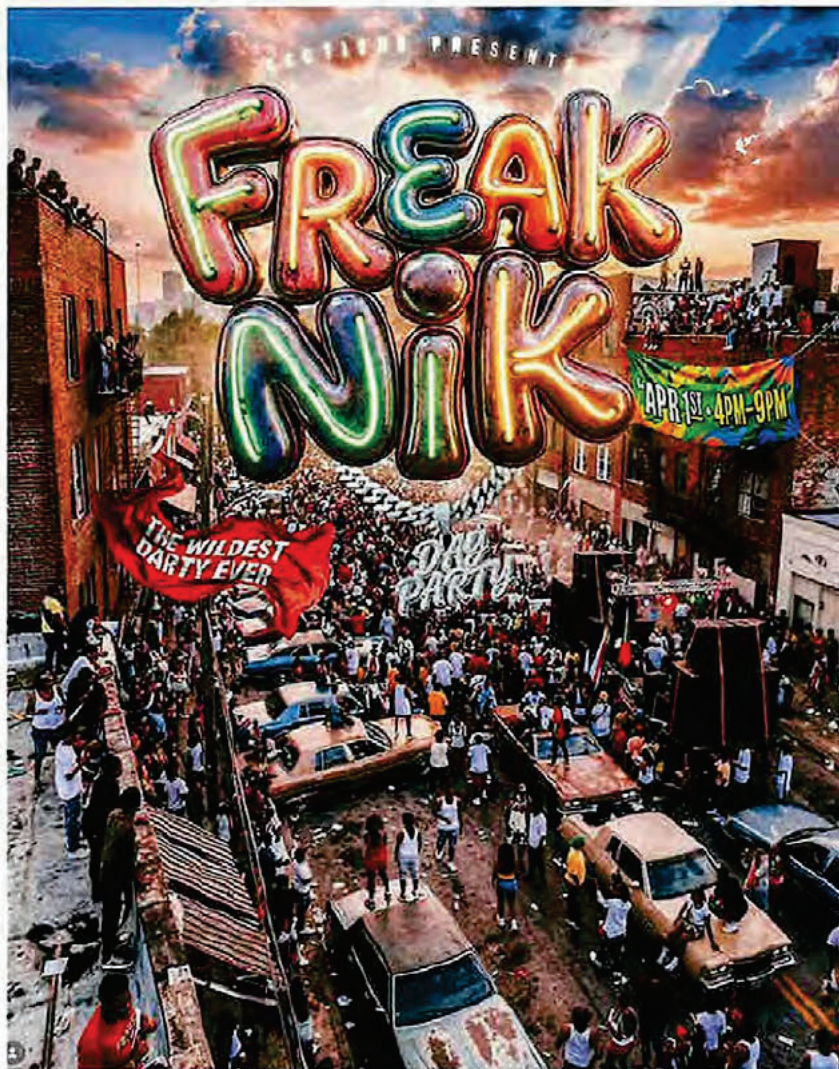

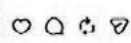
